## COVID ALERT LEVEL 2 UPDATE:

Tēnā koutou Waimata School Whanau

The response required to the latest disappointing news about the return of Covid-19 in New Zealand, is a reminder to remain focussed, vigilant and doing the right thing by following the Ministry of Health guidelines. Anyone feeling unwell or showing any signs or symptoms should stay home and get tested.

***A reminder of the requirements at Alert Level 2, we will continue to emphasise the importance of:***

- Good hand hygiene and cough and sneeze etiquette.
- Staying home from school if sick or even displaying symptoms of sickness.
- Keeping the appropriate physical distance from others where practical.

***We will be ensuring that:***

- High touch surfaces are cleaned and disinfected daily.
- Sanitiser will be available in all classrooms and administration areas.
- We display the QR code poster at our entrances with parents expected to use the COVID Tracer App or alternatively sign in at the office if entering the school buildings during drop offs and pick up times.
- Parents of students displaying any signs of illness will be asked to collect their child(ren) from kura, returning to school only when all symptoms of sickness are gone.
- We keep a visitor register of all visitors to the school.

We know all these things will help to keep our community as safe as possible. We will continue to keep you informed as and when things change.
